

Oral and Poster presentation guidelines

1. Oral presentation

- Speaker should arrive the presentation room 15 minutes prior to the schedule.
- Speaker has only 15 minutes for the presentation (10 minutes for presenting your work and 5 minutes for questions).
- Standard fonts for MS office and Power Point version 2010 or later should be used. PDF is allowed as for your convenience.

2. Poster presentation

- Presenter must be stand by at his/her poster throughout the event.
- Presenter must be at his/her poster at a given time in order to present his/her research to the judges.
- The size of poster must be 80 cm width and 120 cm length. A poster per a research paper is allowed.
- A poster must be written in high standard Thai or English which includes:
 - 1) Title (Both Thai and English, you do NOT need to put Thai research title if you submit a paper in international track)
 - 2) Authors and affiliations
 - 3) Abstract
 - 4) Introduction/Problem statements
 - 5) Research method
 - 6) Experimental results and discussion
 - 7) Conclusion
 - 8) References/Acknowledgements (If any)
